## Before the Meeting Preparation:

Call and remind the older girl (a fifth grade Junior - Senior Girl Scout) to attend the meeting. Ask her to teach "Make New Friends" during the Opening and to assist as needed throughout the meeting.

## **Goals I, II and III: Developing Self-Potential, Relating to Others and Developing Values**

## Supplies and Equipment

---

### **Pre-Meeting Activity - approximately 10 minutes**

Take pictures of girls making different expressions plus one of the girl smiling. One girl could be happy, another angry, a third grumpy, a fourth sad, etc. Group girls for pictures for being helpful, respectful of nature, and other parts of the Girl Scout Law. These pictures will be used as props for the Investiture Ceremony and as girls earn the Learning Petals.

Cameras and film. Props as needed to pose different pictures.

Activity will require extra hands to accomplish everything in ten minutes! Make sure parent helpers are attending today's meeting.

If possible, place tables against the wall, leaving center of room open.

### **Opening Activity - approximately 15 minutes**

Ask older girl to teach *Make New Friends* or another song of choice. As time permits, the older girl may share what it is like to be an older Girl Scout (explain the insignia on her sash, show photos, etc.).

Large sheet of paper with the words to *Make New Friends* or use pictures for word association

---

### **Daisy Circle (Business & Snack) - 10 minutes**

Informal discussion about what is happening in school, home or with friends as snack is passed out. Have each girl clean up after herself. Review safety rules with girls before leaving the building (stay with buddy, stay in eye range of leaders, walk together in buddy line, pick up things off the ground only with permission, etc.).

---

### **Main Activity - approximately 20 minutes**

Introduce the Daisy Girl Scout *Promise Path Game*. This progressive game experience will help girls learn the Girl Scout Promise as they prepare for their Investiture Ceremony.

Refer to attachments (after Meeting 6) for instructions and graphics.

Crayons or fine-line markers

Have girls complete page 10 in the *Daisy Girl Scout Activity Book*.

### **Clean-Up - approximately 10 minutes**

Girls assist leaders with resetting the room. Sweep floor and tidy up as necessary.

---

### **Closing Activity - approximately 5 minutes**

Do a Friendship Squeeze (girls hold the hands of the people to each side of them. Starting with the girl to your left, ask her to gently squeeze the hand of the girl next to her. The next girl then squeeze the hand of the girl next to her. Keep it going until the squeeze is around the circle and reaches you. The older Girl Scout can help with this! Say, "Good-bye Daisy Girl Scouts!" **Send Treat bucket home**
