### Before the Meeting Preparation:

**Bring extra boxes to meeting in case any of the girls forgot a box!** Make discovery boxes. Shoe boxes are just perfect for this project. Decorate them throughout the year with girls' art work. Have scissors, glue, magazines, paints (or crayons) ready. Glue macaroni or dough designs on them.

### Supplies and Equipment

---

#### Pre-Meeting Activity - approximately 10 minutes

Go on a short hike around the meeting place. Collect materials gathered/seen during your short hike (rocks, soda can, wadded up paper, grass, twigs and leaves, empty bottle, flowers (with permission!) are all possibilities).

Discovery boxes

If possible, place tables against the wall, leaving center of room open.

#### Opening Activity - approximately 20 minutes

Decorate boxes. Encourage girls to create their own designs. Invite girls to reach in to each box with their eyes closed. They guess what is in the box, check to see if they were right and move on to the next box. **From time to time, go on another hike and/or ask girls to add personal mementos to their discovery box. This guessing game is always popular and the girls will enjoy playing it throughout the year.**

#### Daisy Circle (Business & Snack) - 10 minutes

Informal discussion about what is happening in school, home or with friends as snack is passed out. Have each girl clean up after herself. Review safety rules with girls before leaving the building (stay with buddy, stay in eye range of leaders, walk together in buddy line, pick up things off the ground only with permission).

#### Main Activity - approximately 15 minutes

Play the Daisy Girl Scout *Promise Path Game*.

Have girls complete page 11 in the *Daisy Girl Scout Activity Book*

#### Clean-Up - approximately 10 minutes

Girls assist leaders with resetting the room. Sweep floor and tidy up as necessary.

---

#### Closing Activity - approximately 5 minutes

Girls gather their belongings, put on their coats and form a circle. Briefly review the environmental activity - what doesn't belong in nature and ask girls for suggestions of how they personally can help keep nature clean. Do a Friendship Squeeze (girls hold the hands of the people to each side of them. Starting with the girl to your left, ask her to gently squeeze the hand of the girl next to her. The next girl then squeeze the hand of the girl next to her. Keep it going until the squeeze is around the circle and reaches you. Say, "Good-bye Daisy Girl Scouts!" Send home Treat Bucket
